The International Seminar “**Clubhouse: an inclusion model for people with mental problems**” is part of the EMPAD Project(*), it’s main objective is to promote the Clubhouse Model. This methodology, promoted by European Union, is focused in giving back their life’s control to people with long term mental health problems. These persons usually suffer some kind of social exclusion, for that reason the Clubhouse Model help them to learn how to deal with their illness and the new challenges involved, also to be part again of social, work, educational and family world.

The Clubhouse Model is based into the Community Based Rehabilitation (CBR) it is oriented into recovery, learning opportunities and integration in the work market for people with mental health illness. The philosophy of the Clubhouse Model is used in the Clubhouses (centers) makes users feel part of a group and also their help is needed for the Clubhouse maintenance and other members welfare. The Model also helps to a step by step learning, including social and work skills. There are internship programs in order to help people to be back in a regular job.
